

Privacy Policy

Keep Moving Pilates respects your right to privacy and is committed to safeguarding the privacy of our customers, website visitors and users of our branded app. We adhere to the National Privacy Principles established by the Privacy Act 1988 (Cth). This policy sets out how we collect and treat your personal information.

This Privacy Policy describes our policies on the collection, use, and disclosure of information about you in connection with your use of our services, including but not limited to those offered through our websites, emails, and mobile application. This Privacy Policy does not apply to any third-party sites that may be linked to the Service.

Personal Information is information that you provide to us, which personally identifies you as an individual to be contacted or identified, such as your name, telephone number, email address and any other data that is tied to such information.

By using the service, you agree that you fully read, understand and accept the terms of the privacy policy. If you do not agree with these terms, please do not use the service. Collecting Personal Information:

We collect personal information provided by you to us such as your name, date of birth, address, email address, phone number, mobile number and Medical History. We might obtain additional personal information including, but not limited to from publications, other publicly forms, when providing your bank account details, credit card and debit card details for payments of your purchases, update any of your contact details, from any third parties or communicate with us in any other way.

You can update and correct your personal information at any time online using our booking software. You can upload and store your profile picture online via our booking software app.

Use of Personal Information:

We collect your personal information to provide, improve and extend our services to you. Your personal information is used to improve your experience at Keep Moving Pilates, for Marketing purposes and to provide you with information and updates. You can subscribe if you wish to receive further information, publications and marketing material. If you do not wish to receive any publications or updates, you can unsubscribe at any time by sending an email to us.

Disclosure of Personal Information:

We may disclose your personal information to any of our employees, officers, insurers, professional advisers, agents, suppliers, subcontractors and other people insofar as reasonably necessary for the purposes set out in this Policy. Storage and Security of Your Personal Information:

Cookies Policy:
